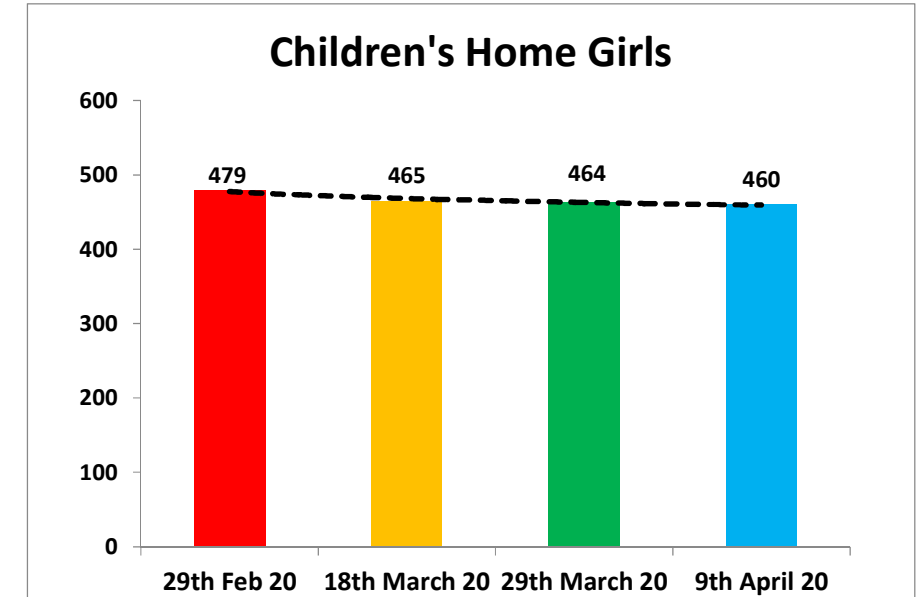
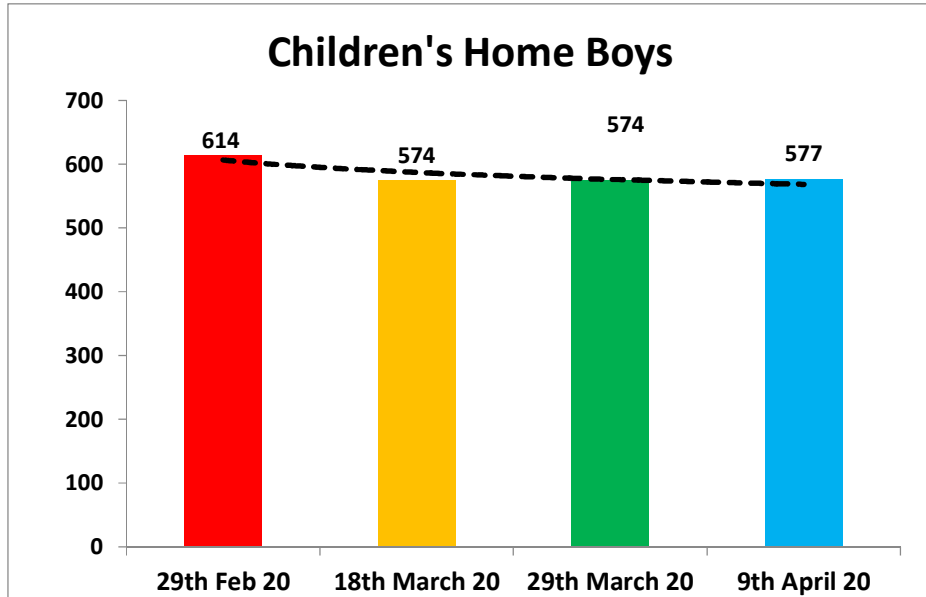
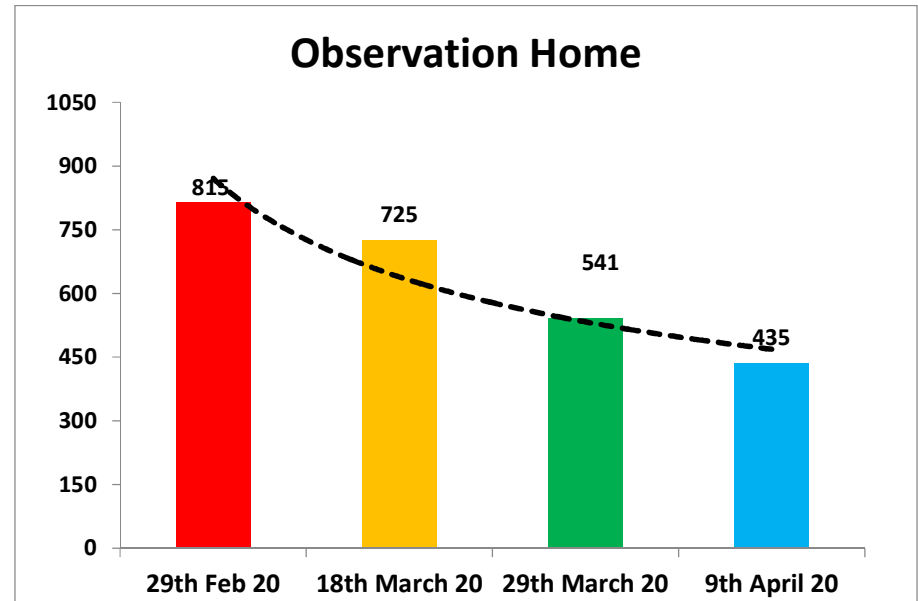
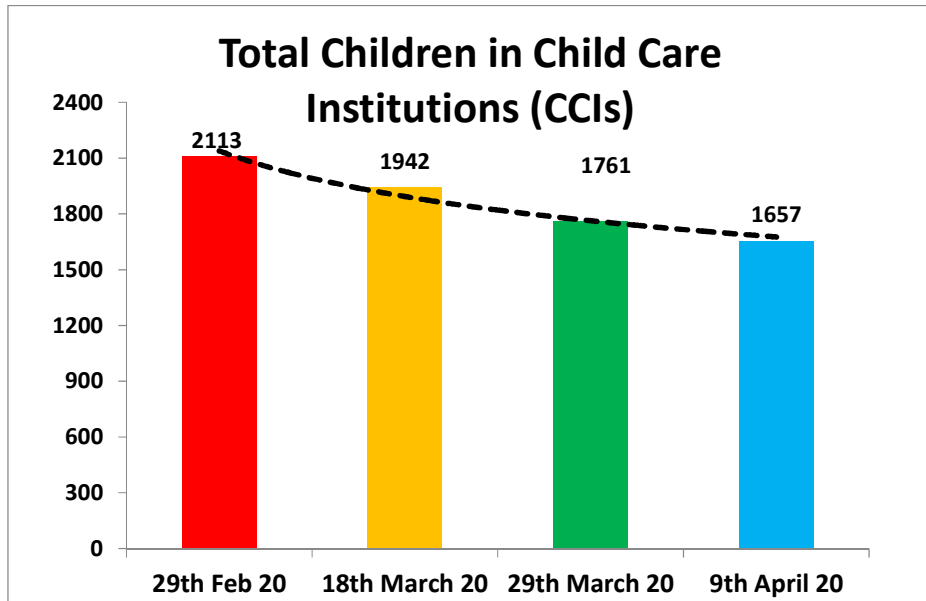
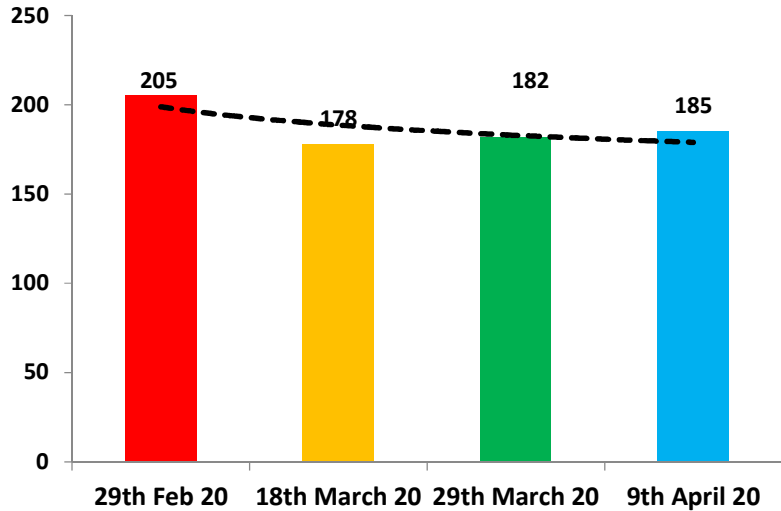


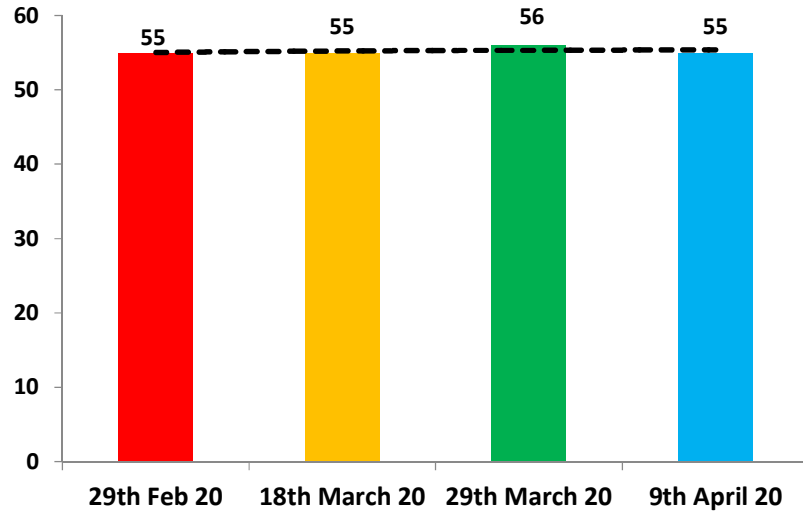
Graphical Presentation of Children in Institutional Care during the month of March-Apr 2020



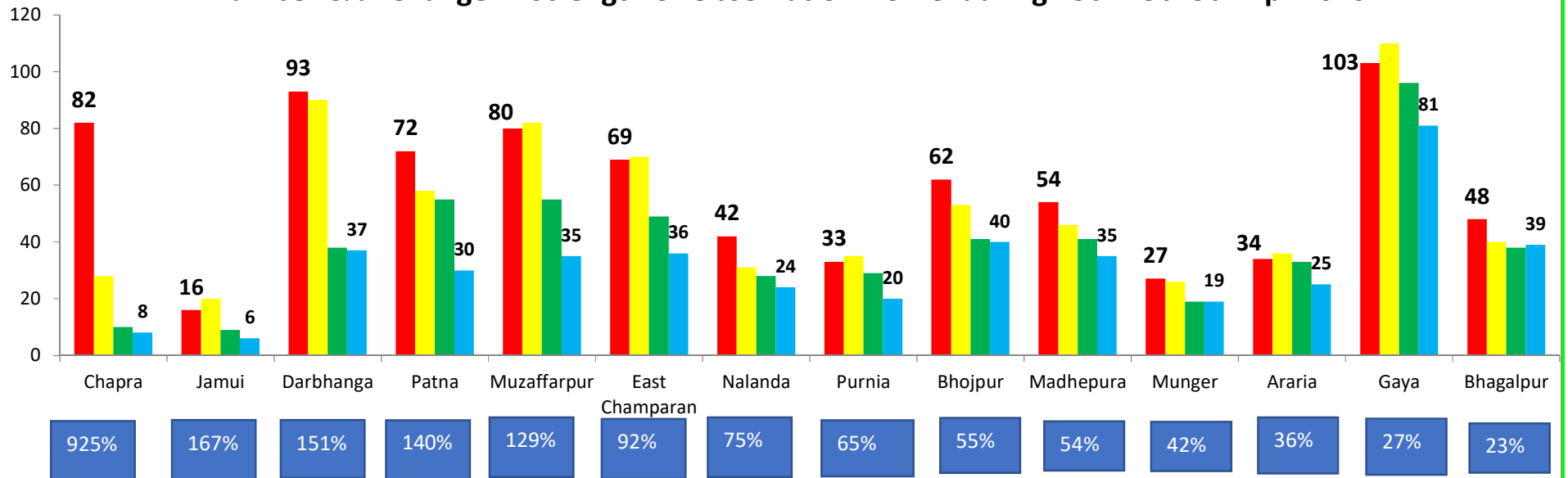

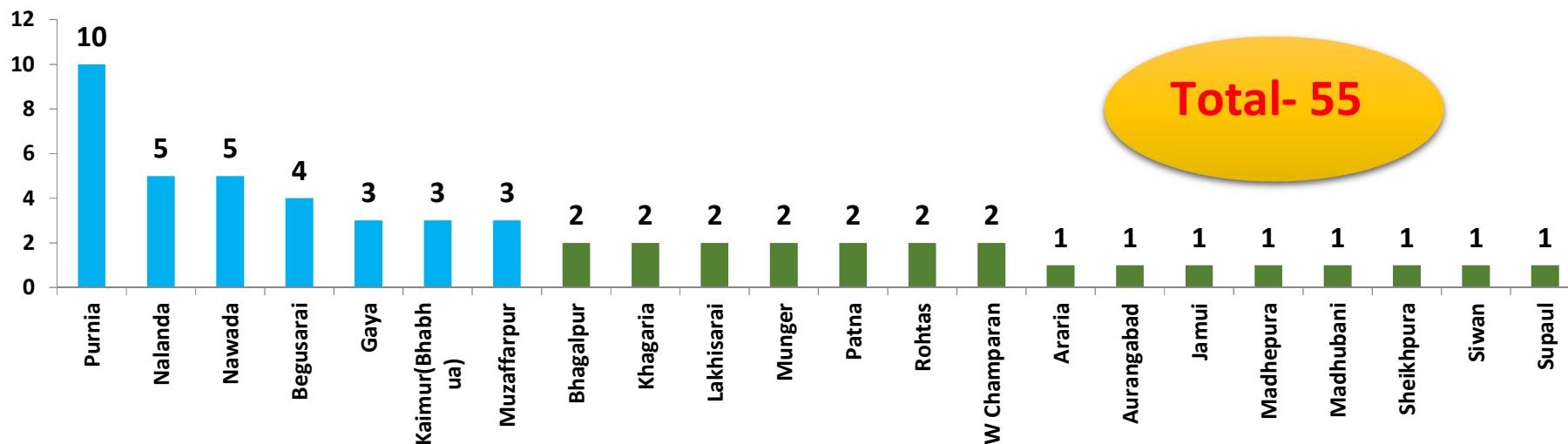


Number & % Change in Strength of Observation Home during 29th Feb -9th Apr 2020

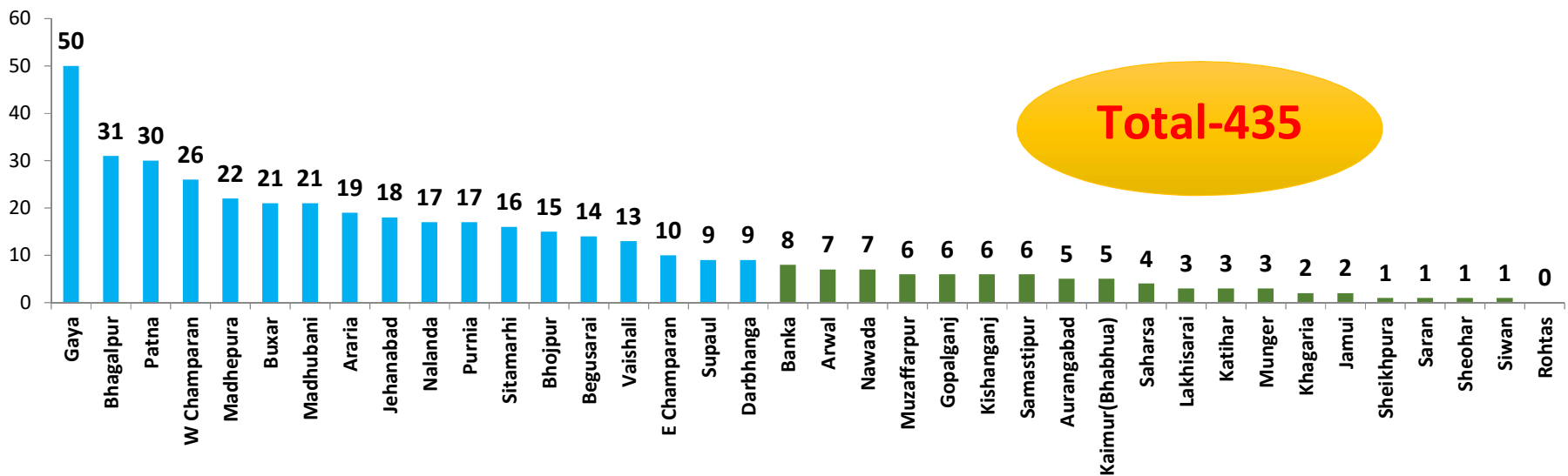


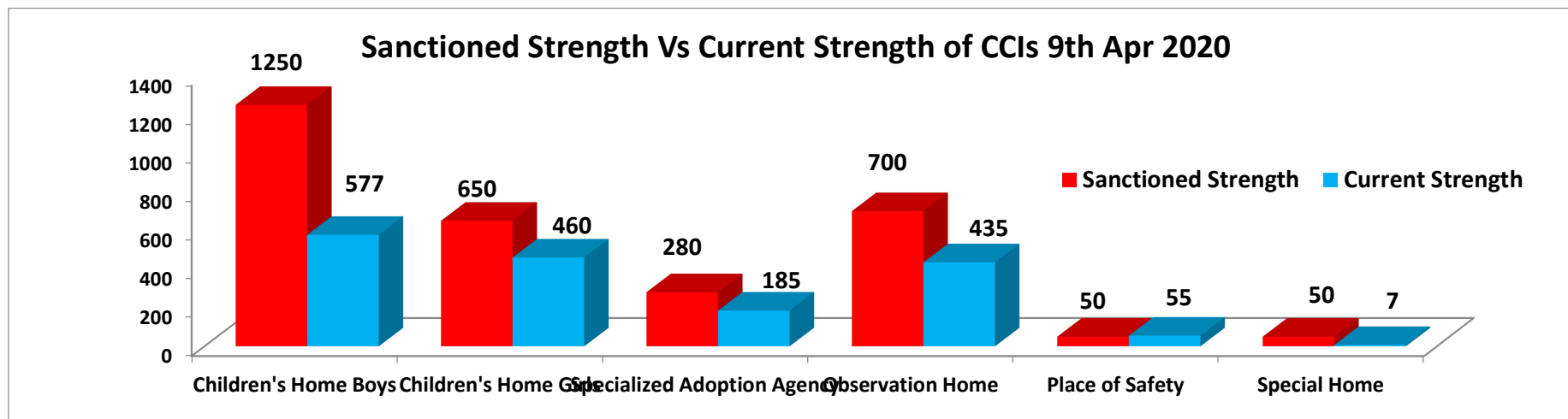

Important steps and observation based on the steps taken by Government and Hon'ble Committee of Juvenile Justice, PHC:

- ❖ Number of new admission of children in both type of Institutions reduced significantly;
- ❖ **More than 20%** reduction in the number of children in institutional Care;
- ❖ No significant reduction in the number of CNCP Children;
- ❖ **High reduction (approx. 50%)** of CICL in Observation home due to Bail, Leave and other Orders in compare to children in end of Feb 2020 ;
- ❖ **In place of Safety number of Children in Conflict with Law is Stagnant.**
- ❖ The numbers of children in some CICL institutions are not decreasing significantly due to concerned JJB/Children's Court.
- ❖ Except few institutions number of Sanctioned strength is less than the Current Strength.
- ❖ Sufficient stock of Sanitizer, Hand Wash, Mask, Floor Cleaner, Soap and others related thing.
- ❖ Regular Inspection of Doctor and health worker for screening of children,
- ❖ Thermal screening, breathing test, cold / cough related investigation, travel history and other test ensure before admission of new children.
- ❖ Isolation ward developed in almost all CCIs for new admitted children.
- ❖ Daily report '**KHARIYAT PRATIVEDAN**' of sanitation, hygiene, food and medical stocks, and reviewing any symptoms related to flu/Covid-19. A cell has been established for collection and compilation of report within SCPS monitored by Director SCPS and daily reporting to Additional Chief Secretary.
- ❖ So far, **No reporting of any symptoms** in children related to KOVID-19.
- ❖ Staffs and children have participated in workshop Organized by MWCD on 7th April 2020 through ZOOM and You Tube live amid Kovid-19
- ❖ Blanket ban on any form of production of children physically to CWCs and JJBs where there are no CCIs
- ❖ Child Care Intuitions are following all the direction given by the Government (State and Central), JJMC and Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- ❖ Advanced allocation of budget (**Apr-June 2020**) to meet all the expensed including salary of Staffs.
- ❖ Several directions have been given to ensure the accountability and transparency.
